Dear Parents:

Enclosed you will find an outline of the courses to be offered at Xavier after Freshman year. In considering your request for next year you should remember the following factors:

(1) The academic course is definitely college preparatory and is intended for the majority of our students.

(2) The classical honors course will only be approved by the Faculty in the case of a student who is doing very well in Latin.

(3) The science honors course will be very difficult and consequently a student must have very good marks in mathematics to be considered for this course.

(4) Generally speaking, French is easier than German and should be elected by most students. Once again the Latin mark will be decisive in the Faculty approval.

We ask you to fill out the form and return it to the school before May 1st. At this time the Faculty will consider your requests and in the light of test scores, academic marks and the opinion of the teachers will decide what is best for your son.

There will be a Father-Son Night on Saturday, April 27th, at 6:00 P. M. Fathers who have the courage may challenge their sons to a basketball game at 6:00. (Running by the fathers will obviously be at a minimum. Some of the Jesuit Scholastics may be persuaded to help the fathers!) Dinner will follow and then we shall retire to the auditorium for a talk by Tony Sardisco, of the Boston Patriots, and a professional football movie. The tickets will cost \$1.50 each. Fathers, uncles, brothers and friends of Xavier students are welcome.

Many of you have heard about Father Talbot's serious accident on March 31st. Father does not teach at Xavier, but resides here and gives retreats. He has made an amazing recovery, and we thank you sincerely for your prayers.

Plans are now being made and bids are being submitted for five buses to supply the transportation next year. We hope to be able to offer more direct service at a reduced rate. When details are definite we shall send the information and forms home with your son. Let's hope he remembers to give it to you!

The following calendar changes should be noted:


Thursday, May 23rd - Holiday - Ascension Thursday
