
Enclosed with this letter and report card marks are the results of your son's Academic Promise Test. The score sheet is self-explanatory but you should remember that this is only one indication of his ability. If the score is a 60 percentile, it means that he scored better than 59% of those who took the test throughout the country. The norm of comparison is a national group of all students and not just students in a college preparatory course.

Our first school play "Ten Little Indians" (an appropriate title!) will be presented in the auditorium at 8:00 P.M. on Saturday, December 15th.

January 2nd will be the Cardinal Cushing Holiday. Consequently, the boys will return from their Christmas vacation on Thursday, January 3rd.
