T O U R R O U T E

From the Office Foyer proceed through the Principal's Office.. down corridor .. Faculty Room .. Language Lab .. classrooms .. through doors .. Student Counselor's Office .. parlors .. Student Chapel .. switch board .. garage .. up stairs or elevator to second floor.

On second floor .. Faculty dining room and kitchen .. return to elevator or stairs and go up to third floor.

Faculty library and Chapel .. Sacristy .. private rooms of Jesuit Faculty .. continue down corridor and down stairs on left to second floor.

On second floor of school wing .. library .. biology lab.. down stairs to first floor .. chemistry lab .. physics lab .. through doors to auditorium foyer .. auditorium .. stage .. gymnasium .. down stairs to shower rooms .. activity rooms .. book store .. cafeteria .. kitchen .. boiler room .. (Those who do not wish to see boiler room should go up stairs after leaving cafeteria to first floor.) .. storage space .. dark room .. up stairs to first floor and end of tour.
