


A Closed Retreat AT GLOUCESTER

WHAT AGE?

From junior year in high school through senior year of college.

HOW MANY IN A GROUP?

Up to forty at one time; no more.

HOW TO ARRANGE A RETREAT

In Catholic schools, consult your principal. Ask your principal to write to us, or offer to write to us yourself.

In public schools consult a friendly teacher, or the Parish C.Y.O.
Ask them to write to us or do it yourself.

WHAT TO BRING WITH YOU

Warm clothing for outdoors. Rubber-soled shoes or rubbers for safety on the rocky cliffs. Informal clothing, if neat, is permitted in the house. Personal toilet articles, such as comb, razor, toothbrush, etc.

WHAT NOT TO BRING

No food or drink of any kind. No blankets, towels, etc. No radios, no sports equipment. No books or magazines or homework.

HOW MUCH WILL IT COST?

\$15.00 for three days. This includes everything except transportation to and from the retreat house.
