
Xavier was founded in 1962 by His Eminence, Richard Cardinal Cushing, Archbishop of Boston who invited the Society of Jesus to staff the school. The educational aim of the school is to prepare boys for college through intensive training in languages, mathematics, science, fine arts, and social sciences. This formation of a Catholic gentleman dedicated to truth and service is accomplished by close adherence to the Jesuit method of instruction, discipline and guidance.

CANDIDATES FOR ADMISSION

Xavier seeks students of strong character and proven scholastic ability who give promise of success in a college preparatory course of study.

The Scholarship-Entrance Examination is administered each year on the second Saturday of February at 9:00 A.M. This examination will cover the basic skills of language and mathematics, vocabulary and reading. Good study habits and wide reading are the best preparation for the examination and for the intensive studies offered at Xavier.

An open-house for interested eighth grade students is held on the fourth Saturday of January at Xavier from 10:00 - 12:30. This gives each candidate the opportunity to meet the Jesuits and the Xavier students, and to see the student activities and school facilities. Parents are welcome to this open-house.

All courses of study at Xavier are college preparatory. Special courses for honor students are offered in the classics and in the sciences. Advanced Placement courses will be offered in several areas.



ATHLETICS

TRANSPORTATION

Direct public transportation is supplied from Harvard Square, East Lexington, Arlington and Maynard by the Middlesex and Boston Ry. Co.; from Fitchburg and Ayer via the Englander Coach Line; from Boston (North Station), Cambridge, and Waltham via the Boston and Maine Railroad.

Private school buses have been organized from such cities as Natick, Wellesley, Newton, Belmont, Woburn, Watertown, Winchester, and Framingham. Students living closer to Concord have been invited to use the buses organized by parents of students at the Rose Hawthorne School.

Plans are being made to add more buses that will run directly and economically from many cities.
